Environmental Policy

INTRODUCTION

Dragoni is aware that sustainable development requires policies, tools, and courses of action to protect the environment. Responsibility to future generations requires a strong commitment to the careful use of natural resources and the minimization of environmental impacts.

The environmental policy was inspired by the Paris Climate Agreement, United Nations Environment Program (UNEP), and European Green Deal.

SCOPE

Demonstrating its attention to the environment and its protection and in line with the principles included in its Code of Ethics, Dragoni, in addition to reaffirming its constant compliance with all applicable legislative and regulatory requirements, formalizes the company's commitment to progressively improve its environmental performance to reduce its impact throughout its value chain.

Dragoni applies the Environmental Policy to its own operations and encourages its suppliers to adopt it.

Dragoni requires suppliers to comply with all applicable regulations in their own state, in addition to the principles of sustainability and environmental protection contained in its Code of Ethics.

In particular, Dragoni has implemented a Due Diligence process in order to evaluate, select suppliers so as to control, reduce the risk of negative events that can cause harmful and serious effects to players along the company's supply chain.

PRIORITIES

Dragoni is committed to reducing CO2 emissions, proper waste management, responsible use of water resources, and the development and use of sustainable products.

Regarding the reduction of GHG emissions, Dragoni directed its efforts toward the following:

- equipping with a photovoltaic power generation system that produces more energy than that consumed by the company;
- purchasing electricity from renewable sources;

- employing more efficient and energy-efficient lighting technologies and systems and promoting responsible management;
- involving suppliers to use materials with lower environmental impacts.

For the proper management of waste and responsible use of water resources, Dragoni is committed to:

- promote responsible use of resources, minimizing waste generation;
- properly manage waste, maximizing recycling and recovery of non-hazardous waste;
- periodically monitor consumption to identify areas for intervention or improvement;
- use products with lower consumption of environmental resources.

With regard to chemicals, Dragoni is committed to using products that comply with the strictest regulations and to:

- rely on suppliers that have appropriate product and system certifications and committed to the progressive elimination of substances harmful to the environment and human health (ZDHC);
- progressively replace the products offered with equivalents with higher sustainability content, such as products certified GOTS (certified cottons or organic fibers), GRS (fabrics with percentages of recycled fiber), FSC ® (viscose fabrics whose origin comes from sustainably managed forests) as well as fabrics produced with the use of environmentally friendly fibers such as Tencel™, Modal ® and Hemp;
- use packaging and materials that are reusable, biodegradable, recyclable and as much as possible recycled and have a low environmental impact;

Dragoni is committed to people's involvement and awareness by promoting a culture of sustainability, which is expressed in its commitment to reducing consumption of paper, plastic, toner, and energy and promoting separate waste collection.

In addition, Dragoni is open to suggestions, information, and proposals that will enable the company to progress and develop sustainability in all areas of its business.

Dragoni's environmental policy is known to stakeholders to share and develop the contained principles and spread the culture of sustainability.
